#4 Pelican Trotting Series

Two-Year-Old Florida Bred Colt/Gelding Trot

 Final Wednesday, October 28, 2009

Each leg will go for \$4,500. Finals will go for \$15,000 plus nomination fees. If entries warrant, consolations may be held for a \$4,500 purse.

General Conditions

1. All events will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, the United States Trotting Association and the isle casino & racing at pompano park.
2. Nominations close by the date specified. No late nominations accepted.
3. If ten (10) or more declare to start, the race shall be divided by lot into divisions.
4. All events will be one mile – one dash.
5. Purse distribution will be 50%, 25%, 12%, 8% and 5%.
6. The finals will be limited to nine (9) separate betting interests. The highest money winners in the preliminary legs will be eligible to the finals. If two or more horses are tied for ninth place, the starter(s) will be drawn by lot. Two (2) also eligibles may be selected from the next two highest money earners that declare in to the final. In the event not enough money winners fail to declare for the finals, starters in the Series that are not money winners may declare for the finals to constitute nine (9) separate betting interests and also eligibles and such entries shall be drawn by lot. Horses must have started in two legs to be eligible to the finals.
7. Should any unforeseen condition prevent the racing of any or all events, monies paid will be refunded.
8. The FSBOA and isle casino & racing at pompano park will jointly agree on cancellation should there be insufficient entries to conduct the series. If cancelled due to lack of entries, sex might be combined. The Race Secretary shall card Florida-sired events in the place of the series to provide racing opportunities for all horses desiring to race.
9. All horses must meet qualifying standards at the isle casino & racing at pompano park before the time of declaration into their first start in the series. Declaration time shall be in accordance with the condition sheet. Declarations to be made with the Pompano Park Race Office. No declarations will be accepted after the box closes. No declarations will be accepted by the FSBOA office.
